



The number of crimes for each area is given along with the crime rate (per 1000 population) and an indication of whether crime has gone up or down in that area compared to the previous year (⊕⊕). Where areas are one standard deviations above average then these areas are highlighted as High Crime levels in Leicestershire County. Where areas are more than two standard deviations above average then these areas are highlighted as highest Crime levels in Leicestershire County. For Total Recorded Crime there are 13 areas with the highest crime in the county. There are 17 high crime areas in the county.	Three types of community classification were used to give an overall picture of the types of communities affected by crime; National Statistics Output Area Classification (OAC); Rural/Urban Definition (England & Wales) and Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) Quintiles for Leicestershire.
