#### **Summary**

A total of 183 offenders were resident in North West Leicestershire.

The adult reoffending rate in North West Leicestershire is 16%, similar to the overall County reoffending rate, 14%.

The most common offender needs identified in North West Leicestershire are 'Relationships' (58%) and 'Attitudes' (46%). There is no significant difference between the needs of offenders in North West Leicestershire compared to the needs of offenders across the rest of the County, with the exception of a higher proportion of offenders with 'Relationship' needs (58%) compared to the County (48%).


