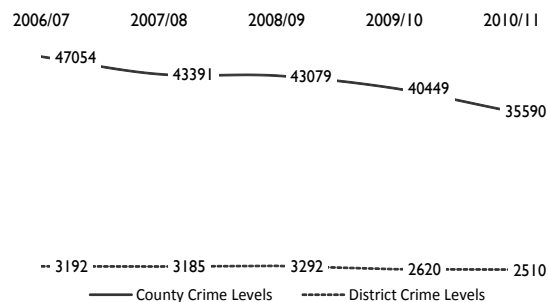

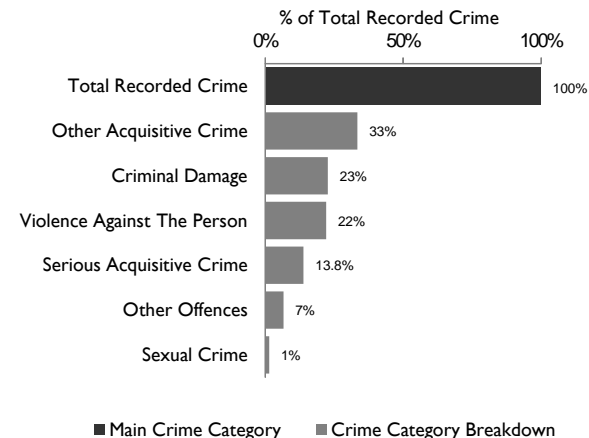
- During 2010/11 Total Recorded Crime fell by 4.2% compared to the previous year. This is worse than the national figure which saw a fall of 4.3%.

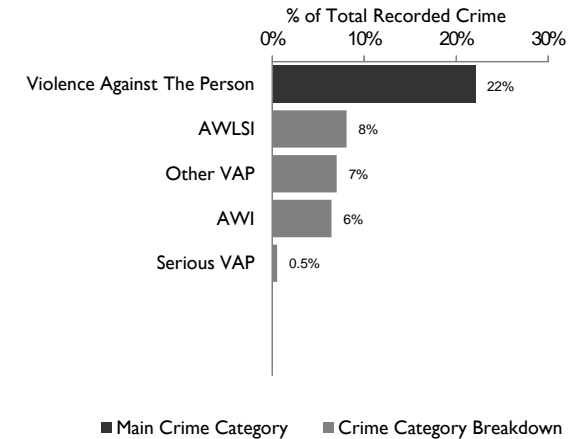

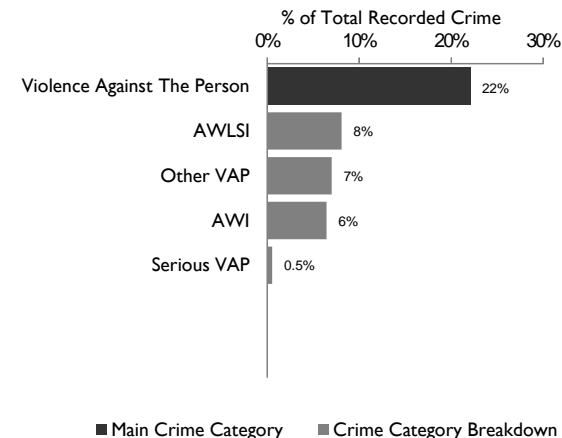

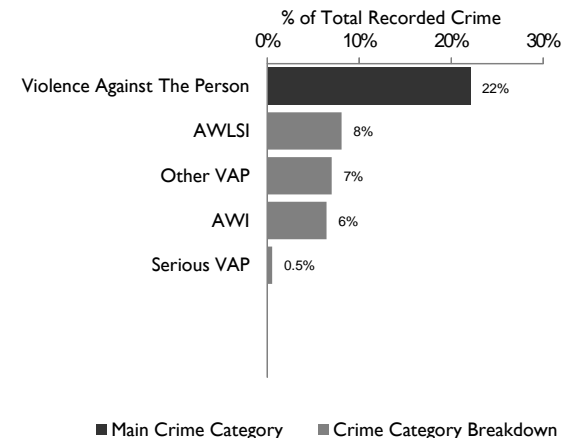

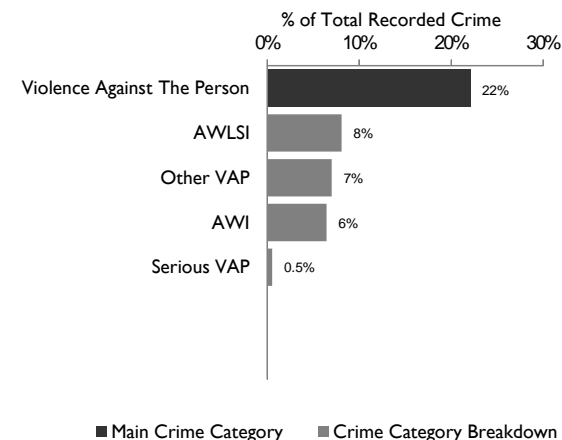

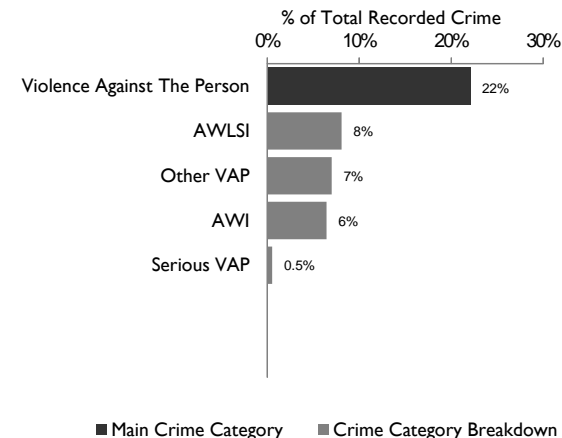

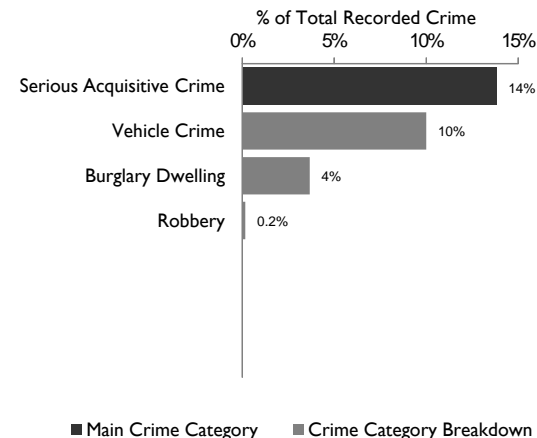

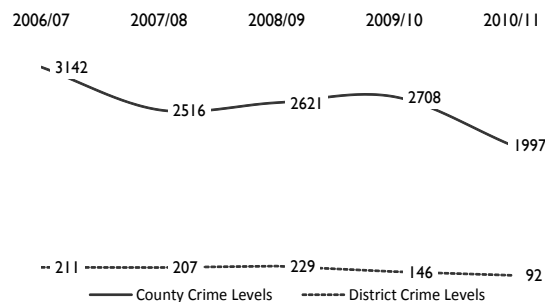

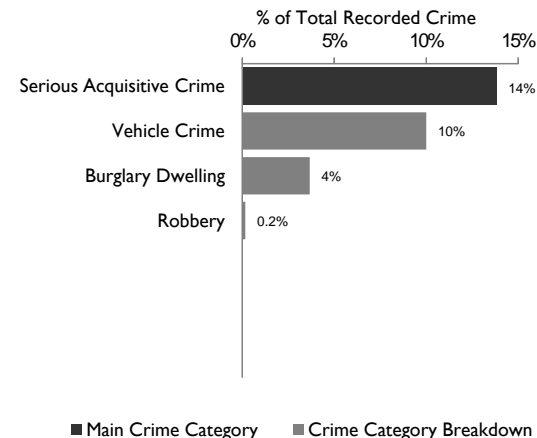

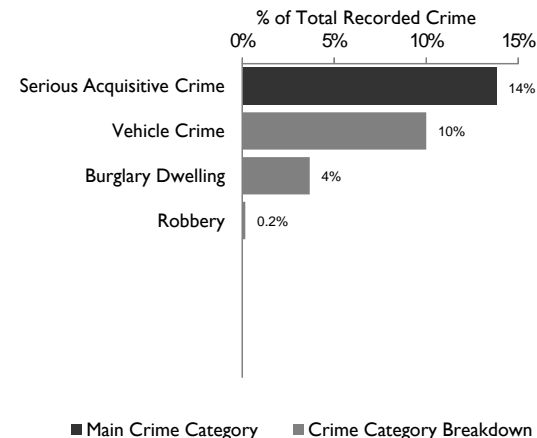
