The number of crimes for each area is given along with the crime rate (per 1000 population) and an indication of whether crime has gone up or down in that area compared to the previous year (↑↓). Where areas are one standard deviations above average then these areas are highlighted as High Crime levels in Leicestershire County. Where areas are more than two standard deviations above average then these areas are highlighted as highest Crime levels in Leicestershire County. For Total Recorded Crime there are 13 areas with the highest crime in the county. 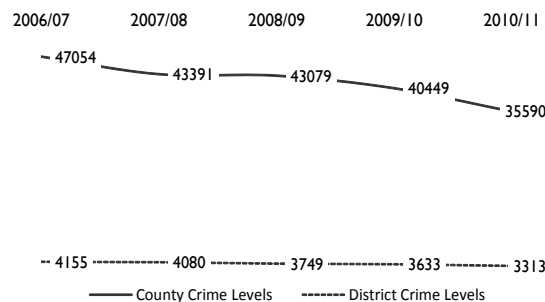

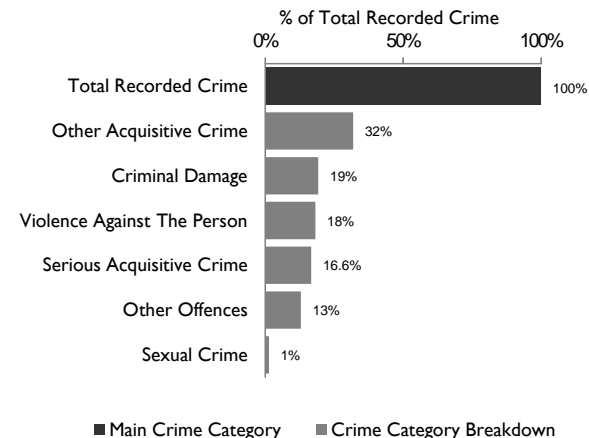
- During 2010/11 Total Recorded Crime fell by 8.8% compared to the previous year. This is better than the national figure which saw a fall of 4.3%.

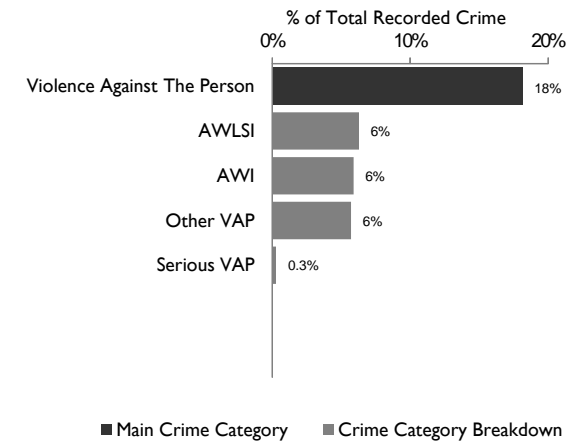

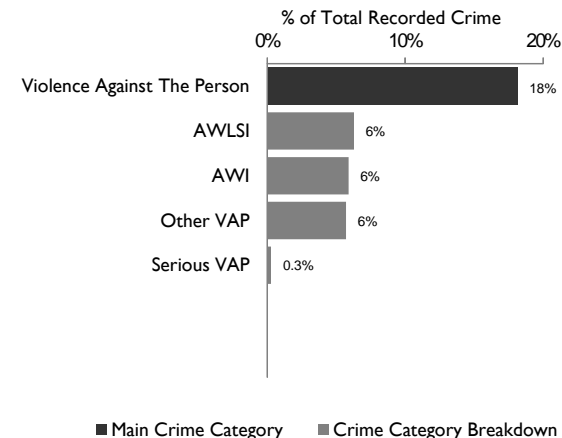

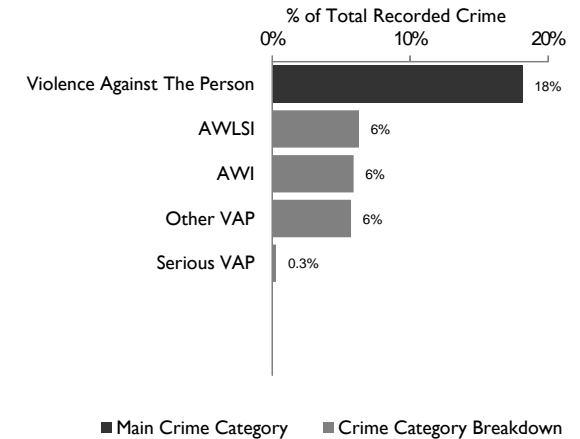

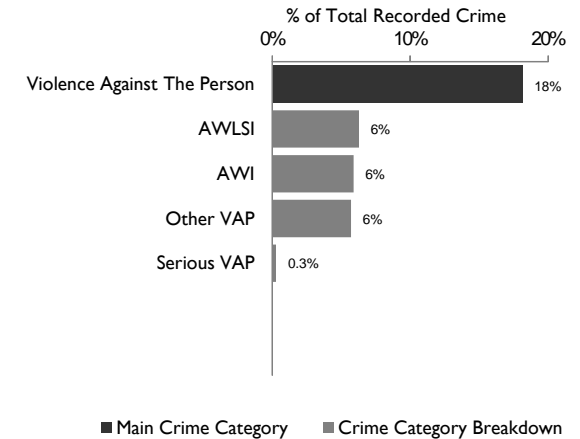

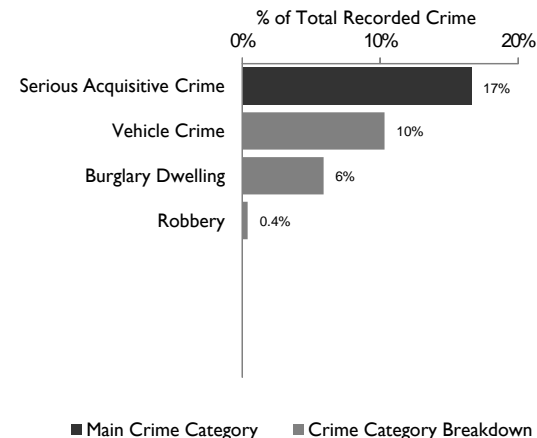

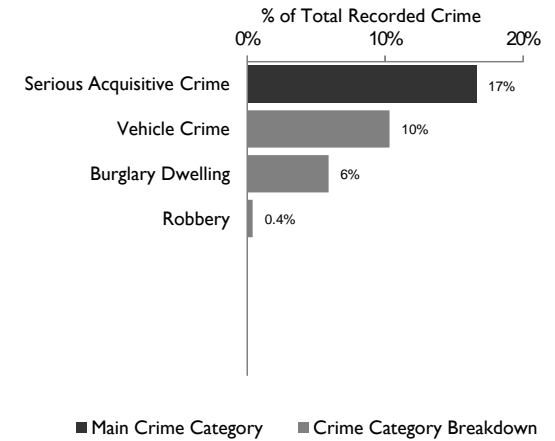

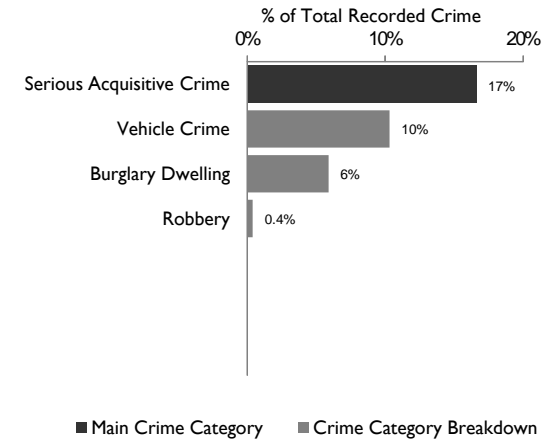
- During 2010/11 Robbery rose by 44.4% compared to the previous year. This is worse than the national figure which saw a rise of 1.4%.

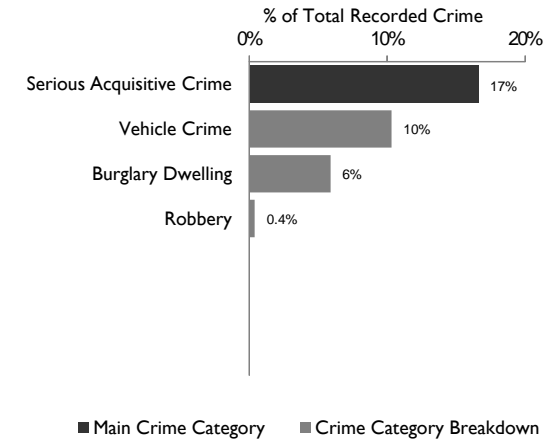

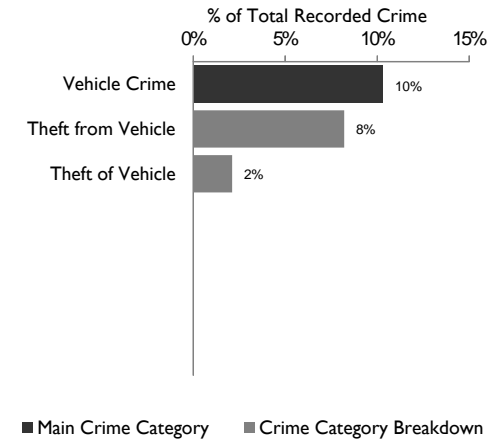
- During 2010/11 Theft of Vehicle fell by 9.1% compared to the previous year. This is better than the national figure which saw a fall of No Data.
