## Unemployment by Ethnicity

JSA benefit data have been published by the Office of National Statistics (ONS) for many years as a key labour market indicator. In November 2006 ONS published JSA claimant data by ethnicity for the first time. The data is available for the detailed ethnic groups down to Local Authority level.

JSA claimant data by ethnicity has been included in Tables 6, 7, and 8 of this bulletin. The JSA data by ethnicity used in these table is a month in arrears of the other claimant count data in the other tables in the bulletin.

Official estimates of unemployment in the UK are obtained from the Annual Population Survey (APS) using the internationally agreed International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition. The ILO definition is based on the number of people without jobs who are looking for work. The APS unemployment figures which are subject to sampling differences are only available for Local Authority (LA) areas. The Claimant Count is released on a monthly basis and is available down to ward level, so is used as a more current indicator of unemployment levels.
