



### Notes

This dashboard includes details of both recorded offences and non-recordable incidents of domestic abuse. All reports of incidents, whether from victims, witnesses or third parties and whether crime realted or not, will result in the registration of an incident report by the police. Following the initial registration, the incident will subsequently by classed as either a recorded offence or a non-recordable incident.

**Recorded Offences :** The police determine whether the circumstances, as reported, amount to a crime defined by law, based on their knowledge of the law and the Home Office Counting Rules (HOCRs).

Non-recordable Incidents: If an incident is reported but does not constitute a recorded offence it is classed as non-recordable incident

All Domestic Abuse incidents: This includes all incidents registered with Leicestershire Constabulary, where the Domestis Abuse flag on CIS is set to 'Y'.

Target: Increase reporting of domestic abuse offences/incidents compared to 2010/11







### **Notes**

Includes all offences recorded as AWLSI (assault with less serious injury), split by domestic and non-domestic offences.

Recorded Offences: The police determine whether the circumstances, as reported, amount to a crime defined by law, based on their knowledge of the law and the counting rules.

Domestic Offences: This includes all incidents registered with Leicestershire Constabulary, where the Domestis Abuse flag on CIS, set by the recording officer, is set to 'Y'.

Assault with Less Serious Injury (AWLSI): Based on the Home Office Counting Rules for Recorded Crime, this includes all offences classed as 8G Actual bodily harm and other injury or 8J Racially or religiously aggravated actual bodily harm and other injury

Target: Reduction in number of assault with less serious injury offences compared to 2010/11
